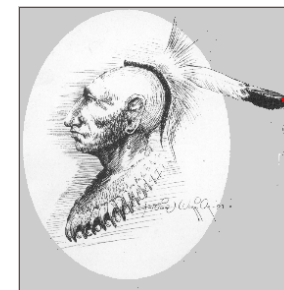
“HERBS, HEALING & HISTORY”

In this calendar the **New England Native American Institute** pays tribute to the Native American wealth of herbal healing knowledge transmitted over hundreds of years through initiation, ceremony and oral tradition. Each month features a beautifully illustrated native herb by NENAI’s own artistic Joyce Heywood, with an accounting of its usage. In recognition of Gladys Tantaquidgeon, who was the Mohegan Medicine Woman, herbalist, and anthropologist from Connecticut, living 106 years, we have chosen to use the Mohegan language for days and months, as well as some vocabulary words.

A brief historical overview narrates the herbal and plant practices and procedures. Interlaced throughout the calendar are colored photos of various herbs in their flowering stages used by Native people. This 8.5 X 11 calendar is designed to be hung on the wall and makes a great gift item.
