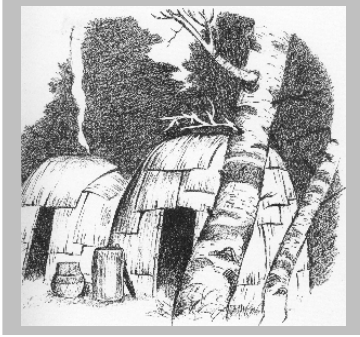

## **SLIDE SHOW AND TALK ON STONE SITES OF NEW ENGLAND**

Cathy Taylor presents a slide show and talk on stone sites of New England on January 10 for NENAI. Preservation of the stone chamber of Upton was a starting point for investigating other sites in the New England area. Interest in archeo-astronomy led to trips to England to see Stonehenge and Avebury and also to Ohio to see the Serpent Mound and the Newark Octagon Mound. Cathy is a member of the Upton Historical Commission and is also a middle school teacher in Franklin MA. She is a member of the New England Antiquities Research Association and has presented twice at the NEARA conferences. The first presentation was on the Ohio earth mounds and the second presentation was on the Great Trail of New England and its connections to Praying Villages and stone chambers. An article entitled "The Great Trail" was later written and printed in the summer 2008 NEARA journal.
